In spite of the pandemic and in spite of the fact that we could not get together for a harvest celebration weekend last year, 2020 was a good year for the Grow Hope Markdale Project. This is good news after a long hard year for all...and it was because of your continuing and faithful support of this project that we can celebrate success!!

The field of soybeans was harvested in October. The yield surpassed our expectations and the selling price for the soybeans was also good. We had hoped to realize \$500 per acre and we actually realized a return of \$600 per acre! All 35 acres were sponsored and additional donations pushed the giving total over \$20,000
