

ANTIHUMAN TRAFFICKING: CANADA

What is trafficking? It is the exploitation, manipulation, or control of a person by violence or threats of violence, to provide a sexual service or to provide forced labour.



CANADIAN STATISTICS

- 93% of Canada's trafficked victims come from Canada.
- According to Stats Canada, the most common form of human trafficking is sex trafficking and the average age is 13 or 14. More than 93% are female.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

BECOME AWARE

Learn how traffickers lure their victims and what signs to look for that indicate someone is being trafficked. Ask NCM Canada for an Anti Human Trafficking information kit or download it at www.ncmcanada.ca. Help protect children and youth. Inform your church and community.

Pray for the victims. Their recovery is very difficult. Pray for healing and that they can be reintegrated into a loving home or independent living.

WHAT WE DO


- Providing safe shelter and care for newly rescued children, who are survivors of cybersex trafficking.

KENYA, MALAWI, BENIN (AFRICA)

Conservation agriculture methods help replenish the nutrients in the soil, retain soil moisture, and reduce weeds – all of which result in higher production of food crops for families in Africa. As farmers see the results, other nearby farmers begin to adopt the methods.

Farmers join "farmers clubs" which incorporate training in new, improved farming methods, solving of common issues faced by farmers, joint marketing strategies etc. The clubs meet in the Church building where the local pastor leads in Bible studies and prayer. As conservation agriculture spreads from village to village, so does the Church!

BECOME AWARE

NCM Canada provides support for local churches overseas that are responding to immediate needs in their community or with longer term rehabilitation projects, helping people retore livelihoods and rebuild their lives.

Currently, we are responding in areas such as Kenya by providing monthly cash transfers to vulnerable families, and in Haiti, through our partnership with Canadian Foodgrains Bank and ADRA Kenya, we supported a Food Distribution project that targeted over 2,000 families.

We continue to support the NCM response to refugees leaving the Ukraine and to the needs of displaced families within the Ukraine.

BECOME AWARE

Sponsor an acre of crop for \$400 which pays for:

- preparation of the soil
- seed, fertilizer, cost to plant the crop
- weed control
- harvest
- storage and transport of the crop
- some land rental costs

The farmer plants, cares for the crop, harvests, and sells it. The expected return is about \$500 per acre which goes to the Canadian Foodgrains Bank. Depending ont the project, it may be matched up to 4:1 by the Canadian government. \$400 becomes as much as \$2500 worth of food for hungry families.
